He woke up inside a moving truck and never fully left.





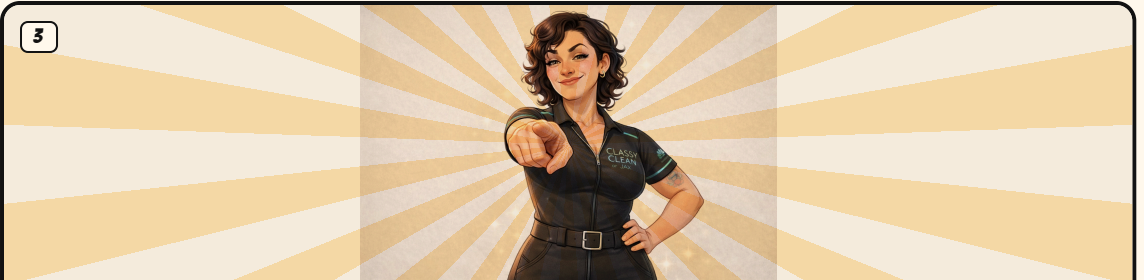
MOVING DAY. THE TRUCK IS LOADED. SOMETHING IN THE EMPTY LIVING ROOM IS NOT.
